With this amendment please realize the possibility that cattle will likely need to be rotated out of the Monument pasture, before the off date of 11/30/2004, and put into the Lodge pasture. As a reminder, please keep in mind that fence #2077A, the fence between the Lodge and Diamond pastures, must be in such a condition as to be effective in keeping the cattle out of the Daimond pasture before cattle will be allowed into the Lodge pasture. We have provided you with a few names and numbers of individuals that may be able to help you in fixing this fence, and would encourage you to explore these possibilities.
